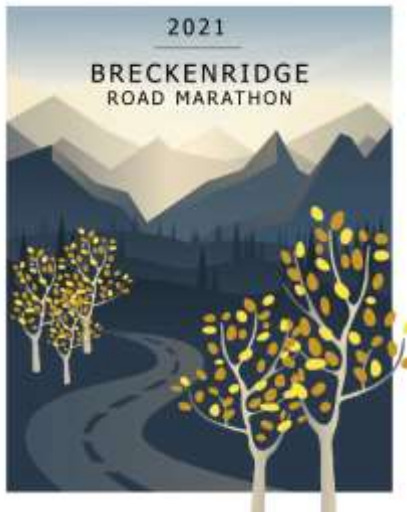

RACE DAY

PARKING

Race day parking for all participants will be located at the **Breck Recreation Center, 880 Airport Rd, Breckenridge, CO 80424**. We have designated parking for our participants, the shuttles will be picking you up from this location and you will also finish your race here.

SHUTTLE TO STARTLINE

All participants will be shuttled to the start line, via Epic Mountain Express. **Shuttle pick-up is at a NEW location this year, the Breckenridge Recreation Center**, beginning at 6:15 am. Shuttles will run continuously from 6:15-8:10 am (final shuttle for half and full marathon departs at 7:45 am). Please make sure to leave plenty of time. There is no parking at the start line, if you choose to have someone drop you off, they will not be able to stay. This is mandatory for the safety of all participants. **ALL Participants riding the shuttle WILL BE REQUIRED to wear a mask during transportation. This is a requirement from our shuttle provider for the safety of all riders.** Masks will be provided if needed.

START LINE

Upon Arrival to the start line, we will have coffee and a light breakfast for you provided by Cabin Coffee Co.! There will be portable restrooms, gear check and plenty of room to warm up.

***IMPORTANT* WE WILL BE CHECKING IN ALL PARTICIPANTS AT THE START LINE. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU CHECK-IN WITH A VOLUNTEER.**



Gear check will be available for anyone who would like to check a bag at the start line. The weather projects high of 52/ low of 36 on race day. It does have the ability to be very cold on the mountain in the mornings so please be prepared, we have had snow in the past. All bags will be transported to finish line and post-race party after the start of the race.

COURSE

There are 4 different events, Marathon, ½ Marathon, 10K and Kids Mile. Water Stations will be located roughly every 2 - 2.5 miles, there will be 4 FULL stations with water, electrolyte drink and snacks, the remaining stations will be water only.

***IMPORTANT* WE ARE A CUPLESS COURSE, WE WILL PROVIDE ALL RUNNERS WITH A REUSABLE SILI-CUP TO USE DURING THE RACE. THERE WILL NOT BE ANY CUPS AVAILABLE ON THE COURSE.**

TIMING

[Negative Split Productions](#) will be timing the Breckenridge Road Marathon this year! will be timed using a B-TAG System. All runners will receive an official race bib with a B-TAG permanently affixed.

****IMPORTANT:** Runners may run with only their assigned bib and may not wear an additional bib for someone else. We have a ZERO Tolerance Policy for cheating and the individual owners of both bibs will be disqualified.

COURSE CUT-OFF

The course cut-off for the marathon/ half-marathon will be 7 hours, 3PM. Those who do not finish in the allotted time will not receive an official time.

RUNNER RESPONSIBILITY

You are running this race at your own risk and will encounter mountain terrain. Please be aware that you could encounter hazardous weather or wildlife during this race. Roads and bike paths remain open to the public, please be aware of vehicles and other users. Runners and Spectators must be respectful of other trail users. If you are running with music, we ask that you remove one ear bud, so that you can hear what is going on around you.

****IMPORTANT:** As the Race Director, we reserve the right to cancel, delay or post-pone the event due to inclement weather or other safety reasons. Refunds for such occasion will NOT be available.

We are a stroller friendly event, however, some areas on the course are narrow and we kindly ask that you are considerate of the other runners. If you need to start near the back, please do so and allow the faster runners to go ahead.

The Town of Breckenridge is VERY pet friendly, and your pets are welcome to spectate the event with your family and friends, however we DO NOT allow pets on the course.

SPECTATORS

If you have family members that are interested in spectating on the course, there are several areas that would be great for them. Here is a list of some accessible locations;
